



## **BEHAVIOUR POLICY ADDENDUM 2020** **COVID – 19**

At Greenland Community Primary School we aim to maintain a secure, caring and stimulating environment in which children are encouraged to have respect for themselves and each other. Whilst expectations in our Behaviour Policy remain pertinent, it is necessary, in light of the Covid-19 pandemic, to make some adjustments for the safety of all pupils and staff. It is to be used in conjunction with, and read alongside, the Behaviour Policy. These adjustments are set out below:

### **5. General Behaviour Management**

Due to restrictions on bubbles and mixing, the Pupil Parliament is unable to meet. Consequently, there will be no new Lunchtime Charter for this academic year.

### **7. House Point System**

House points are currently not operating in school due to factors regarding the mixing of bubbles. Currently, no assemblies are taking place in school in order to reduce the movement of children and bubble mixing.

Class teachers continue to use their own class rewards system to promote positive behaviour.

### **8. Dealing with unacceptable behaviour**

In the COVID-19 situation Positive Handling will be avoided at all costs. In the event that all other support techniques do not work and the child is at immediate danger to themselves or others, Positive Handling may have to be used as an immediate safety precaution. Where a child may need very close contact it is imperative that parents know that the use of PPE, where appropriate, WILL be used to help avoid cross contamination or any potential virus spread.

In the case of a child being at risk, putting others at risk or damaging property the child's parents or carers will be called and asked to pick up their child immediately. The situation will then be reviewed by the Head teacher and a decision of whether the onsite education offer will be withdrawn in favour of the online/virtual offer if this is deemed safer for all pupils and staff.

### **13. Playtimes and Lunchtimes**

Buddies are not currently in operation in school due to the movement between bubbles.

The MUGA and playground is used by Key Stage 2 bubbles during playtimes and lunchtimes on a weekly rotational basis (LKS2 and UKS2).

Whole school Sports Leaders are not in operation due to the prohibiting of movement of bubbles.
